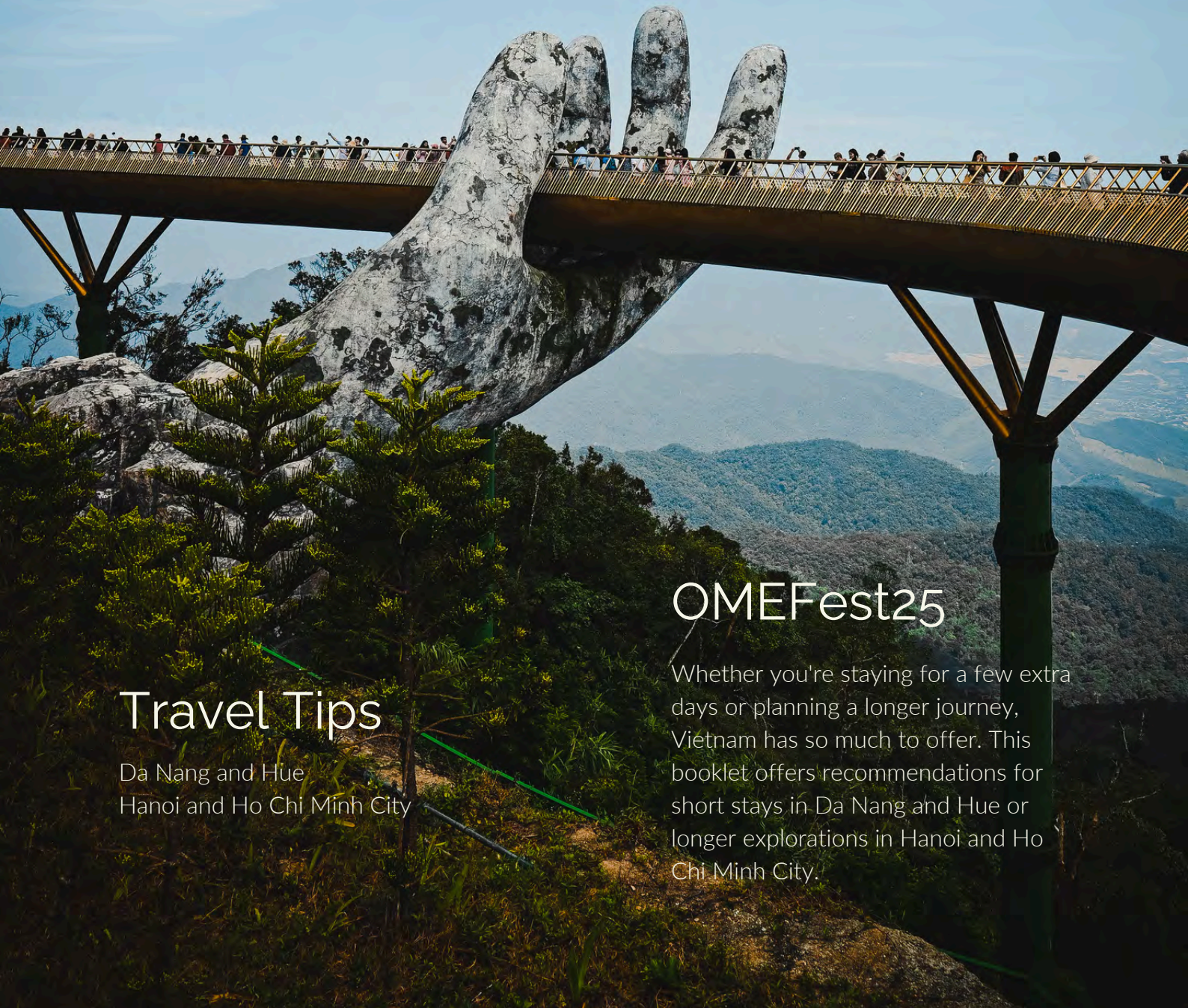

#### **Travel Tips:**

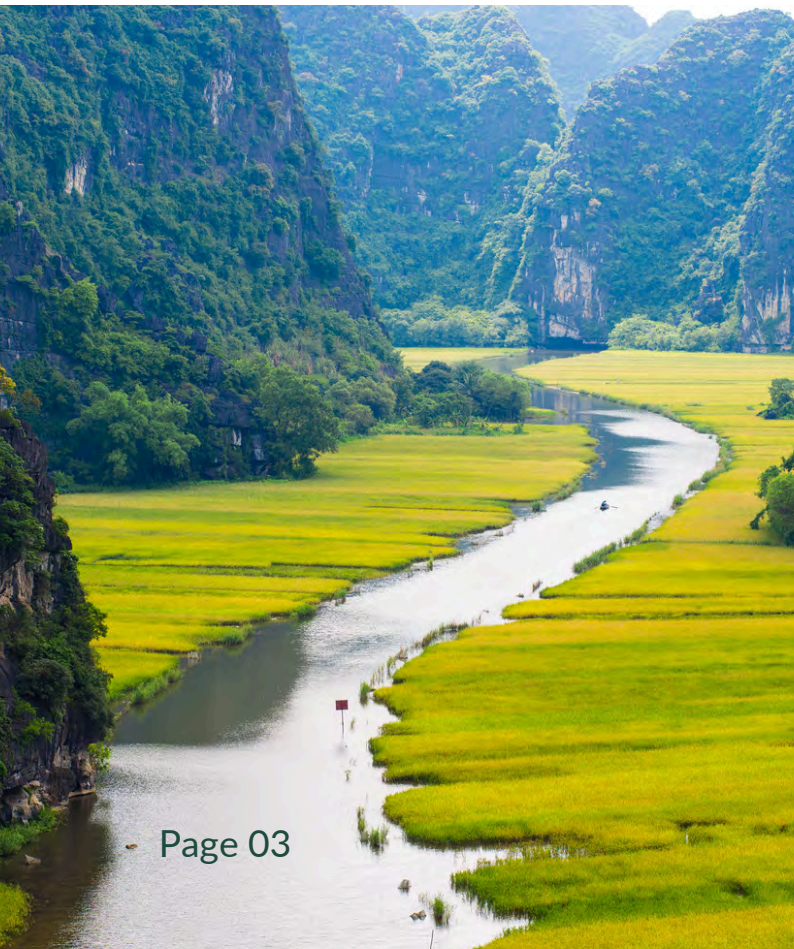
- Da Nang and Hue are easily accessible by car (no flights are needed), making it simple to explore nearby cities and their stunning landscapes.

# Hue

Hue, Vietnam's former imperial capital, is rich in history and cultural heritage and a 2,5 hour drive from Hoi An.

4. **Tombs of Emperors** – Explore the grand tombs of past Nguyen Dynasty rulers.
  - Tomb of Minh Mang: National Route 49, Huong Tho, Huong Tra, Thua Thien Hue, Vietnam
  - Tomb of Tu Duc: Thuy Xuan, Hue, Thua Thien Hue, Vietnam
  - Tomb of Khai Dinh: Thuy Bang, Huong Thuy, Thua Thien Hue, Vietnam
5. **Dong Ba Market** – Try the famous bún bò Huế (spicy beef noodle soup).

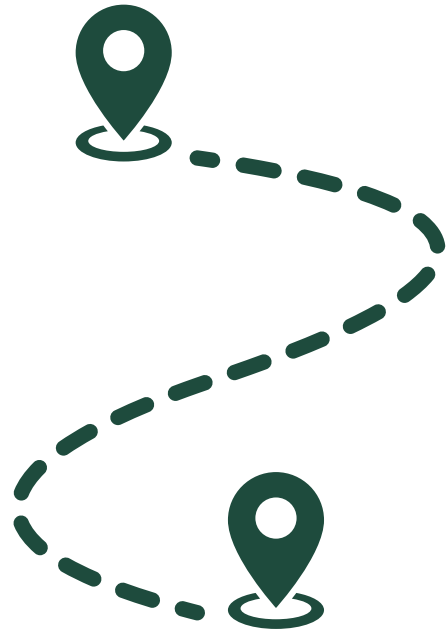
